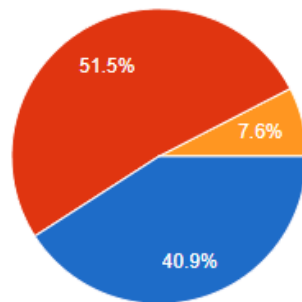


Parental Survey September 2021

1. Which option would you prefer regarding our notification of a positive (PCR) case in the school?

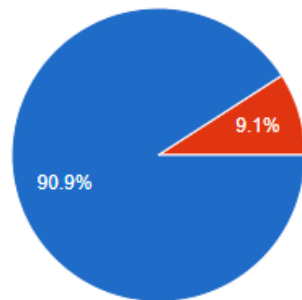

- Please send an email for the first positive case in my child's class and then only inform me again, if five pupils in the class test positive. After ten days, we would start notifying you again of any new cases.

2. Removing the staggered school day - School drop off times. Prior to COVID-19, you could drop your child off at school at any time between 8.40am and 8.50am. We are proposing that from Monday 18.10.21, we go back to this but extend the time so you can drop off between 8.35am and 8.50am. We are particularly conscious that some Y3 children don't come into school until 9.05am but if you are in Y3 and have a sibling in in Y2, you could come into school at 8.35am so we need to remove the COVID-19 staggered school day. Please note that Nursery will still start at 8.40am.

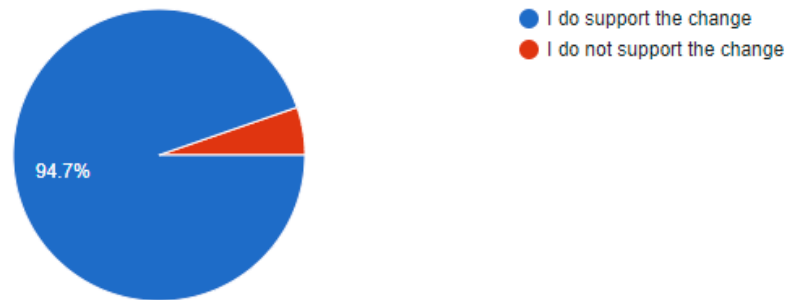

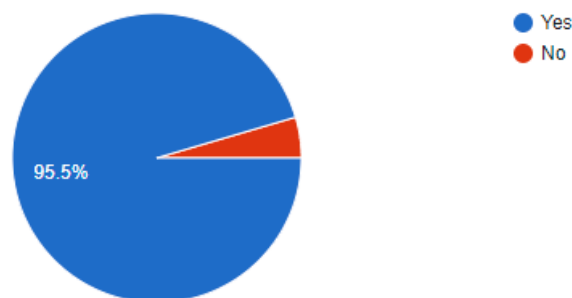
3. Removing the staggered school day - School pick up times. Prior to COVID-19, the school pick up times were as follows: YR - 3.00pm, Y1/Y2 - 3.0pm and Y3/Y4/Y5/Y6 - 3.15pm. Dismissing the children safely is our priority and we accept that we are not going to be able to meet the wishes of every family. However, we hope that the condensed times will alleviate the long wait that some families currently have. Therefore, we are proposing that from Monday 18.10.21, the following times will apply:

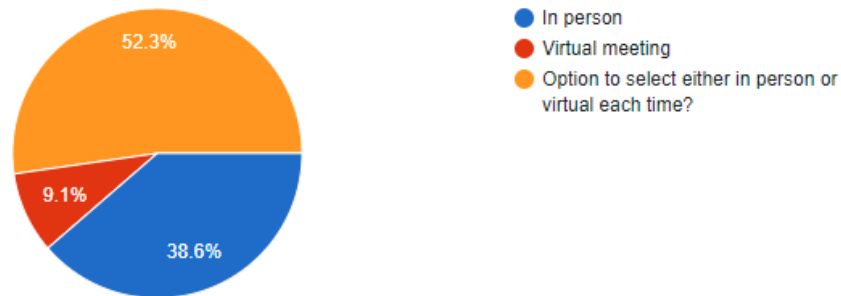

5. We will be offering parents/carers the option to select either a virtual or face to face meeting for the Parent/Carer Teacher Consultation – More information will follow before October half term.
