



Dear Parents/Carers,

Autumn Term Arrangements

Extended Services will be reopening from Wednesday 2 September for all our returning YR to Y5 children and from Thursday 1 October for children in our new YR classes, with some small changes.

Further to government guidance on protective measures, the children will remain in their year group bubbles, where they will be sure to have fun, in a safe and caring environment, with varied activities to suit everyone, in a classroom and using our outside space across the whole school site.

Due to the current pandemic and operational restrictions, we have had to make some changes to our normal session drop off and pick up arrangements. Therefore, children must be dropped off/collected from the South Gate at the following times:

Sunrise: Children must be dropped at the South Gate at either 7.30am, 7.45am or 8.15am

Sunset: Children must be collected from the South Gate at either 4.30pm or 5.30pm.

These are the only times when staff will be at the South Gate to assist. If you arrive outside of these times then you will need to wait until the next time slot. The school office runs separately to Extended Services so they will be unable to help with drop off/ collection.

Sunset will close earlier than the normal time of 6.00pm due to staffing levels as we are operating out of 7 locations around the school building instead of the usual one. Sunset will have a reduced cost of £14.00 whilst this earlier pick up time is in operation.

I appreciate the lack of flexibility is restrictive but in order to open Extended Services as per the government guidelines we have had to make these temporary operational changes. If the government guidance changes, we will review our provision and write to you again.

Breakfast will be served at 7.45am dinner will be served at 4.45pm. Meals will be eaten in the year group classroom where the children will be for the whole Sunrise or Sunset session. The new menu, from Aspens, will be available on the website at the beginning of term.

We look forward to seeing you again in September.
