One way this is done is by running an optional daily 'Cosy Club' in the Club Room where the younger children have the opportunity to choose from a variety of activities such as:

- Exploring the book corner, reading with an adult
- Arts and crafts in the Creative Area
- Construction and Small World play on the carpet
- Role play and dressing up
- Board games and puzzles
- Messy play—outside the club room

Members of staff will support and reassure the children as well as encourage them to make new friends. There is also a buddy system with older Sunset children who have particular skills in helping new children to feel included and valued.
