Dear Parents/Carers,

PTA Family Stay and Play Event

After the popular success of our previous Family Stay and Play events, we are offering you the chance once again, to come and join us for a fun afternoon of games and activities.

The event will take place after school (3.15pm – 6.00pm) on Friday 20 September and we would love you all to come together for a great afternoon. Children will be dismissed as usual so that you can enter as a family. The PTA Stay and Play will be an opportunity for children, friends and family to enjoy some sports and activities which will take place on the playground, ball cage, all weather pitch and the slope. Please note that the top field will not be supervised or have any official activities taking place on it so any children wishing to play in this area need to do so with parent supervision.

There will be a bar and BBQ for you to enjoy especially for those who have worked up a thirst and appetite after participating in all of the activities! Due to licensing restrictions, parents/carers are not permitted to bring their own alcohol onto school premises. Smoking and vaping on school ground is also strictly forbidden.

Places for this event should be purchased via the PTA Events website by Thursday 19 September 2019 at noon and the cost of entry is as follows: Adults £1.50 and Children £2.50. Please note that a child place will need to be purchased for all children aged 1 and above. Children under the age of 1 will be admitted for free.

Places purchased in advance will be emailed via the PTA Events system to you or can be downloaded via your orders in your PTA Events Account. On the night please bring a print out of your 'tickets' or download them onto your phone. All 'tickets' will be checked at the gate, there will be no entry without a ticket.

Should you wish to pay on the day, the cost of entry will be as follows: Adult £2.00 and Children £3.00. Please bring the correct amount for quick admission.

If you purchased a ticket previously for the Stay and Play event in June that was cancelled due to adverse weather, there is no need for you to purchase your ticket again.

Call for help!

As always, the PTA would not be able to run these events without the assistance of volunteers. In line with our other events this year, the PTA are allocating Stay and Play to a section of the school with the expectation that volunteers linked to the nominated year groups will assist (in this case we require volunteers for the BBQ, and for supervision of the top playground and the all-weather surface).

This event has been allocated to Key Stage 1 (YR, Y1, Y2) and we would request that, in particular, volunteers linked to those year groups go to the PTA Events website to sign up and volunteer (YR – all weather, Y1 – top playground, Y2 – BBQ).

We would obviously encourage any of you to volunteer please; it is just that we are particularly asking those linked to KS1 year groups to specifically help out.

Children attending Sunset

After reviewing the event last year, the decision has been taken that Sunset children will not be able to attend this Stay and Play event with Sunset staff. Instead, Sunset have organised a special afternoon of activities for the children and will be serving a BBQ style tea. However, if another parent wants to collect your child and take them to Stay and Play, please ensure that they have a print out of their 'ticket' and let Sunset know that they will not be attending the session.
