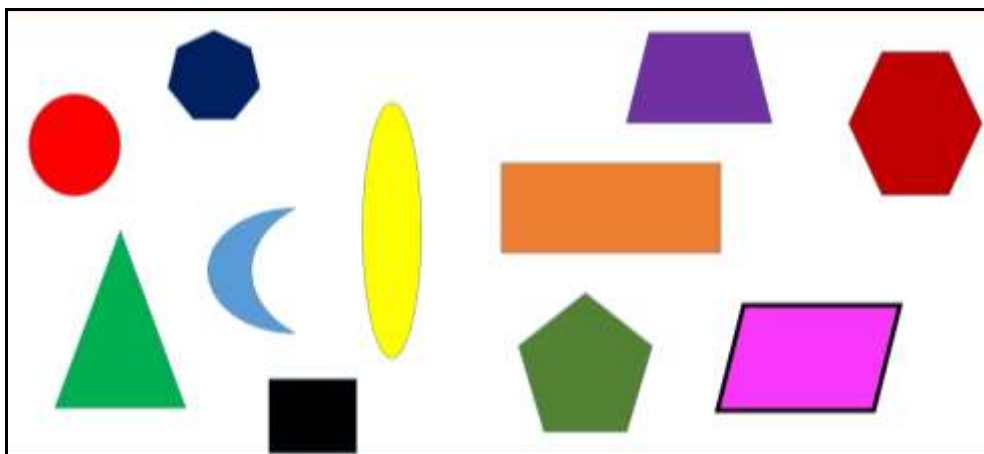
This week we continue to learn about superheroes. We will look at the stories Super Daisy, How to Save a Superhero, 10 Little Superheroes and Super Worm to inspire us to create our own superheroes. What unique powers can you think of? This week's writing skill is labelling using full sentences.




The two new sounds that the children will learn in Phonics this week are: digraph 'er' as in 'mixer' and the trigraph 'ure' as in 'vulture'.

Please practise recognising and writing all of the sounds we have learnt so far. Our new tricky word is '**have**'. So far we have learnt the tricky words: **I, the, to, go, no, into, he, she, we, me, was, you, they, all, are, my, her** and **said**. Tricky words cannot be sounded out, but need to be recognised on sight.



In our daily maths meetings we will recap the **2d** shapes that we have learnt. Can your child name the shapes below?



We continue to work on **subtraction** and we will also investigate **doubling**. Please see the ideas below:
