In English this week, we will be practicing using prefixes and suffixes. We will be focusing on 'mis', 're', 'ly' and 'less' so that we can apply this in our writing.

In maths, we will be continuing with addition and subtraction using 3 digit and 2 digit numbers. We will be practicing using the column method with an exchange and looking at a variety of representations.

Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 21.10.19

In English lessons this week, we will be learning to improve and edit our work. We will also be reviewing our reading test to see where we could improve. This week, we will be having a 20 word spelling test from the Year 4 spelling list. We will record this in their Learning Journal so you are able to see which words your child needs to practise.

In maths, the children will be learning to estimate by using rounding and we will be using the inverse as a checking strategy. In addition, we will be practising our number bonds to 100 and focusing on ways to learn our times tables. Your support with helping your children to learn their tables is greatly appreciated.

Coming up soon in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 21.10.19	*Know 8x table at speed Add and subtract hundreds and 3-digit numbers. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Divide any number by 10. Know pairs of numbers to 100.
w/b 28.10.19	* Give change from £1 at speed Know 8x table at speed Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Add and subtract tens with 3-digit numbers at speed. Know pairs of tens to 90

As part of our themed learning, Greece is the Word, the children will be learning about the Ancient Olympic Games and comparing them with the modern day Olympics. We will then be holding our own mini Olympic Games. In computing, we will be continuing to work on writing algorithms to create our maze game.

On Thursday, we will be cooking for the Great Harvest Bake Off. Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 21.10.19

This week in English, we will be editing and improving, and then writing our final draft of persuasive writing. Having worked on our 'non-negotiables' of capital letters, full stops, question marks, commas for lists and apostrophes for contraction, we will be ensuring all of these are used correctly in our writing.

In spelling we will be exploring words with the suffixes –cious and –tious. To help learn the spelling of words ending in either –cious or –tious we will be learning that:

- If the root word ends in ce e.g. space, remove the e and replace with ious.
e.g. space – spacious
- If the root word ends in tion e.g. nutrition, remove the n and replace with us.
e.g. nutrition – nutritious

There are some exceptions to the above rules e.g. delicious, fictitious, anxious. These exceptions just need to be learnt.

In maths, we will be exploring BIDMAS - the order of operations to carry out calculations involving the four operations (brackets, indices, division, multiplication, addition, subtraction). We will then be looking at using efficient mental strategies and deepening our understanding of the four operations and how the inverse can be used. Finally we will be looking at simplifying fractions.

We are looking forward to **cooking** our fairy cakes for the Great Harvest Bake Off on Wednesday! Please can the children bring into school all the ingredients and equipment they have volunteered to. The children will be weighing the ingredients at school.

On Thursday we will be **decorating** the cakes, so please can the children bring in any items for decorating on that day (including bowls/spoons if they are making icing). Thank you so much for your support with this.
