Y2 Sleepover – Final information

Our annual Year 2 sleepover is nearly upon us and the children are very excited; as are we! All the money raised this year will go towards toys and equipment for the playground so thank you for your support.

What will we be doing?

At the start of the evening we play games for the first hour and then the children will have a light supper. This will take us up to approximately 9.00pm. After that the children will then get ready for bed and make their beds.

Once the children are settled in their beds a film is started and the children have a cup full of popcorn (if wanted). Once the popcorn is finished the children are sent to clean their teeth. Afterwards, some children fall asleep during the film and others sit and watch the whole thing.

When the film has finished, the lights are turned out and the children are then encouraged to sleep. At least four adults are in the room at any one time and the children are never left on their own. They should all be asleep by 10.30/11.00pm.

Where will we be?

We will stay on school premises and will be sleeping in the hall. The Y1 classrooms will be used for breakfast and bed storage.

Friday evening

Doors will be opened at 7.00pm. Please can you come in through the main doors by the office. Staff will greet you at the entrance to the hall and sign your child in, checking we have your correct contact details for the night.

Please then bring your child into the hall and you will be directed where to put their things. Once you have said goodnight and they are seated on the floor then please leave the hall and enjoy the rest of your evening.

Any blow-up beds, camping beds or roll mats are welcome but please may we kindly request that they are inflated by you, either before you come to school or once you are here so we can focus on entertaining the children. Can I also ask that no mobile phones, iPads or handheld computers be brought to school, as we cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage and we have lots of fun things planned so there won't be any time to play on them.

The children have suggested that they would like to bring their slippers or warm socks from home for extra comfort and late night visits to the toilets so feel free to pack them.

Saturday morning

In the morning the children will be waiting for you, at 8.00am, where you left them. Please come in through the main doors by the office. When we see you, your child will be free to go home after

collecting their things. We will have a lost property table outside the hall because you can guarantee there will be some things left behind! Please check it before leaving.

We have had lots of forms back, thank you, but we have also had a few payments but no forms and forms but no payments.
