Nursery Weekly Information – w/b 16.9.19



Welcome to our Nursery!

We have loved our first week. The children have done so well. There is so much to take in, lots of new names and routines to learn.

Our focus is all on settling the children and helping them to navigate around the Nursery, ensuring they know where everything is and encouraging them to be independent. Our activities will reflect the interests of the children and what they have expressed as their favourite things to do.

We would like to thank you all for being brave and dropping off your little ones and making a quick exit. We know it's hard, well done to you all!

Polite reminders:

- Please make sure your child has these items with them each morning:
 1. Book Bag
 2. A named fruit snack (fruits such as grapes must be halved)
 3. Lunch (if they are having packed lunch)
 4. Coat
 5. Water bottle
- Please make sure your child has these items that will be left in school at all times:
 1. A change of clothes bag (in a named drawstring bag)
 2. Welly boots
- Please make sure EVERY item is named, thank you.

Lunches

If your child is having a packed lunch we recommend you don't over fill them. We suggest they have three items. They are not allowed fruit or fizzy drinks, nut products including pesto and chocolate spread or sweets. If any of these items are brought in they will be removed.

Snacks

They will need one piece of named fruit every day. This will be placed in the snack basket when they come in, please don't pack it in their lunch box. All grapes, blueberries etc must be chopped up.

Learning Journals

Please comment in your child's learning journal each evening. Write down what book you have read together and a short comment on how it went. Maybe they asked a lovely question, answered your questions or predicted the ending?

There will be a box of books outside each classroom. Your child is welcome to swap their book each morning.

Communication

There are several ways that we can communicate in Nursery.

- You will receive the 'Weekly Information' every week. It is our opportunity to fill you in on our plans for the week ahead and if we have any reminders.
