Nursery Weekly Information – w/b 2.3.20



We have an exciting week this week as we will be focusing on the Nursery rhyme 'Old MacDonald' as part of World Book Day. We are continuing with our theme 'Hickory Dickory Dock'. Please could children bring in a baking potato on **Thursday** so we can decorate it as their favourite book or Nursery rhyme character. For Monday – Wednesday children, please could they bring in a potato next Monday as they will do their World Book Day activity then.

This week we are:

- Singing a selection of nursery rhymes focusing on Old MacDonald
- Dressing up as our favourite book characters on Thursday
- Learning the names of the animal babies on the farm.
- Printing with vegetables using mud paint.

This week we are encouraging the children to do up the zips on their coats by themselves. This is a tricky skill. At Nursery we help some of the children by getting the zip ready at the bottom and connecting the two halves before encouraging them to pull up the zip themselves. Once they have mastered this skill we can then help them manage it all by themselves. Some of the younger children will still practise putting on the coat (and turning the sleeves the right way round first if they are inside out).
