Nursery Weekly Information – w/b 14.9.20 For our new and returning families



Our Nursery team would like to welcome all of our new families. We are looking forward to the busy week ahead and cannot wait to see all of the children come together and have lots of fun! Our focus will be on settling the children and making sure they are familiar with the staff and their surroundings.

A couple of reminders...

- Please make sure all spare clothes are in a drawstring bag with a name clearly displayed on the front.
- They will need a named fruit snack each day, only fresh or dried fruit or vegetables. Due to COVID-19 please use a disposable bag not Tupperware.
- They will need a pair of wellies to be in school at all times. Please ensure the name is visible and if possible on the outside or on the sole of the boot.
- They will need a named water bottle everyday.
- Please own every item they own that is brought into school! We will be able to quickly get lost items back to you if they are named.

Staggered entry for new children

We look forward to having your children, here is a reminder of the timings:

- Group 1 – 9.30am - 11.30am
- Group 2 – 12.15pm - 2.15pm

Remember to be brave! If your little one is feeling nervous then have a big smile and say you will be there to collect them soon. If they wobble it is always best to hand them over quickly so that the anxiety doesn't escalate, please trust that the staff will take good care of them. We will meet your child at the South or West Gate in the morning. Due to social distancing, we will not be able to physically carry an unsettled child from you, so please feel free to call us if you need another plan to be made. At the end of the session, we will bring your child to you at each gate.

For these sessions, the children will only need a water bottle and coat. However please bring in a change of clothes bag on the first day; it will then stay in school. Other equipment, mentioned above can be brought in when the group sessions have concluded.
