



Homework Passport Values Buttons Guidance

When completing your homework passport tasks you might have to demonstrate some of our school values such as effort, resilience and making good choices. Each week, your teacher will reward you between 0 and 2 Homework Passport Values Buttons (HPVB) for effort and completion of the tasks set. For exceptional homework, an extra HPVB (gold in colour) may be awarded to a 'homework hero', giving an absolute maximum of 3 HPVB per week. In each class there will be up to 2 'homework heroes' per week.

How do the HPVB tickets work?

Your ticket will be attached to the inside back cover of your homework book. When your teacher marks your homework, they will sign off the amount of HPVB you have earned that week. You can save up your HPVB and exchange them for a number of rewards in the HPVB shop.

How do I redeem my HPVB?

When you would like to exchange your HPVB, take your ticket to Ms Saunt in the office. You should tell her what you wish to buy and she will put hole-punches in the HPVB you have used up. She will give you a certificate as a 'receipt' of your purchase and, if needed, will inform your teacher about what you have bought, including any important information such as the dates things have been booked – e.g. muffi days.

What can I get for my HPVB?

1.	Line leader for the day	5 HPVB
2.	Lunch queue pass	8 HPVB
3.	Chair in assembly for you and a friend	10 HPVB
4.	Chair in assembly for yourself	15 HPVB
5.	Lucky dip from the celebration assembly basket	15 HPVB
6.	Seat at the teacher's desk for the day	20 HPVB
7.	A seat at the next Captain's table for you and a friend	25 HPVB
8.	Hair styling with Mrs James	30 HPVB
9.	10 minutes of extra playtime for your class	30 HPVB
10.	½ hour board games session for the class	30 HPVB
11.	½ hour 'tech time' with the iPads for the class	35 HPVB
12.	Muffi day for you and a friend	40 HPVB
13.	Your choice of songs on the music 'bells' for the week	45 HPVB
14.	20 minutes of extra playtime for your class	50 HPVB
15.	Homework task pass for one week NB: You must still complete Learning Journal the week you use the pass and you must have already completed both compulsory tasks that half term before you redeem your HPVB.	50 HPVB
16.	Class muffi day – for your class or another class	60 HPVB

What happens if I lose my ticket?

Responsibility is one of our school values, so you must look after your ticket. Unfortunately, if you lose your HPVB ticket or homework book containing your ticket, you will not get a new one until the next half term when the next homework passport will begin and you will lose any HPVB previously earned.
